

Math Quiz Revision Guide

Complete the following steps on a NEW piece of lined paper to earn more points.

DO NOT ERASE OR CHANGE YOUR ORIGINAL WORK!

1. Fold your paper in half, down the center, to create two columns.
2. In the LEFT column, correct your errors. Recopy from the beginning, showing complete, correct work and a correct solution.
3. For EACH error, write a sentence in the right column that explains:
 - a. What was your error?
 - b. What did you need to KNOW or LEARN in order to fix it?

It should look something like this:

Integer Addition & Subtraction Revision

(Correct the Problem.)

(Explain what you did wrong.)

<p>#5) $-9 - (-6)$ $-9 + 6$ -3</p>	<p><i>I originally added $9+6$ to get -15. I needed to learn that when you subtract a negative, the value increases.</i></p>
<p>#8) $-10 + -18$ -28</p>	<p><i>I forgot to write the negative sign on my sum. I knew to add the two negative values together, but need to remember to check my signs.</i></p>

4. When you have corrected all of the errors in your original work, check with Mrs. Friberg to make sure the entire assignment is now complete and correct. You can even check in problem by problem as you go.
5. Staple your original work to the back of your revision work.
